HIGH PERFORMANCE SAILING CENTRE PRINCIPE FELIPE

The Specialized High Performances Sailing Centre (CEAR) Príncipe Felipe, under the Royal Spanish Sailing Federation, is currently one of the top sailing high performance centres and team bases in Spain.

Located in Santander, CEAR Príncipe Felipe is listed by the Consejo Superior de Deportes (Spanish National Sports Council) as one of the nine High Performance Centres operating in Spain, and as one of the top five centres focusing exclusively on just one sport.

Since it was opened in 1995 as a High Performance Centre and later transformed into Specialized High Performance Centre in 2008, the CEAR Príncipe Felipe has effectively served and supported not only Spanish sailing teams, but also international teams, serving mainly as a base and training centre for the Spanish Olympic Team.

One of the main objectives of Santander's CEAR Príncipe Felipe is becoming a world benchmark among the most important high performance centres, both in the services rendered and in its self-sustainability.
