



## NOTICE OF RACE

### 42<sup>nd</sup> PALAMOS – CHRISTMAS RACE

**PALAMÓS, SPAIN 17 to 22 December 2017**

The 42 CHRISTMAS RACE will be held in the Bay of Palamós from 17 to 22 December 2017

The regatta will be organized by Club de Vela Palamós / Club Nàutic Costa Brava, Authorised by the Real Federación Española de Vela and Federació Catalana de Vela

For classes 470 M &W and Nacra 17 the 42<sup>nd</sup> Christmas Race will be *Copa de España*, for classes 49er and FX the 42nd Christmas Race will be *Campeonato de España*.

This Regatta is part of the COEV (Spanish Olympic Sailing Circuit).

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 RSS Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, will apply.
- 1.3 For Medal Stage Races, World Sailing Addendum Q, Umpired Fleet Racing, available on the World Sailing website (<http://www.sailing.org>) will apply and changes a number of racing rules. The version that is current when the regatta begins will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.4 The RFEV Prescriptions will apply. [http://www.rfev.es/uploaded\\_files/prescripciones-rfev-v3-2013-2016-espaaol-ingles2.pdf](http://www.rfev.es/uploaded_files/prescripciones-rfev-v3-2013-2016-espaaol-ingles2.pdf) 126 es.pdf
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

#### 2. ADVERTISING and BOW NUMBERS

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display bow numbers and advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 Competitors and coaches shall enter by completing the on-line entry form on the event website <http://www.christmasrace.org>

Online entry opens on 1st August 2017. Entries must be received and paid no later than 17 November 2017 to qualify for the early entry fee.

Entry in the event is not final until registration is completed.

3.2 Eligibility shall apply. Each athlete shall be registered as a World Sailing Sailor on the World Sailing website: [www.sailing.org/isafsailor](http://www.sailing.org/isafsailor)

3.3 Olympic gender requirements will apply for each Olympic event and Youth event however men and mixed teams are also eligible to compete in the women's 49erFX event.

3.4. Competitors under 18 years of age shall present a signed and completed parent (or guardian) consent and declaration form at registration. The forms are available for download on the event website <http://www.christmasrace.org>

3.5 The regatta is open to boats competing in events chosen for the 2020 Olympic Sailing Competition and the World Sailing Youth Classes.

3.7 The organizing authority may cancel an event if the minimum number of entries has not been received by midnight (local time), 1 December 2017.

Competitors will be notified of cancelled events by email and posting on the event website. The entry fees for cancelled events will be refunded.

## 4. FEES

4.1 Fees are stated in Euros and include any local taxes. Entries received and paid by **17 November 2017** will qualify for the early Entry fee.

4.2 If an entry is cancelled by the competitor, the entry fee will be refunded as follows:

## 5. FORMAT

5.1 For Olympic events the regatta will consist of an opening series and a Medal Stage. The opening series may be divided into a qualifying series and a final series. The top 10 finishers in the opening series of each event will advance to the medal stage which is to be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

For Youth events and invited Class the regatta will consist of a single series.

5.2 Others formats may be used as authorized by RFEV / World Sailing in preparation for the 2020 Olympic Games.

## 6. SCHEDULE

6.1 Registration for competitors, coaches and team leaders is scheduled from 09:30h to 19:30h on Sunday, 17<sup>th</sup> December 2017 at Club de Vela Palamós / Club Nàutic Costa Brava venue.

6.2 The first Meteo briefing for coaches and team leaders is scheduled at 09:00h on Monday, 18<sup>th</sup> December 2017 at Club de Vela Palamós / Club Nàutic Costa Brava venue.

6.4 On the last day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 16:00 h.

## 7. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

7.1 Each boat shall have a valid measurement certificate (if required by the Class rules). Boats shall use the approved Nationality Code Letters on their sails as required by the RRS.

7.2 Competitors shall produce evidence of membership of the appropriate Class association at the time of registration as may be required by the Organizing Authority.

7.3 Boats may be subject to inspection at any time during the event. The procedures for inspections will be specified in the Sailing Instructions or Equipment Inspection Regulations (EIR).

7.5 The equipment limitations as specified in the Class rules shall apply.

## 8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available beginning 17<sup>th</sup> December 2017 at registration and on the event website. Other documents governing the event will be published with the Sailing Instructions.

## 9. VENUE

9.1 The regatta venues will be Club Vela Palamós / Club Nàutic Costa Brava and the Palamós Beach.

9.2 The racing area will be in Palamós Bay, Palamós, Girona, Spain.

## 10. THE COURSES

The courses will be Windward/Leeward or Trapezoid except that any other courses adopted by World Sailing for the 2020 Olympic Sailing Competition may also be used.

## 11. PENALTY SYSTEM

For the Men's Skiff, Women's Skiff, Mixed Two Person Multihull and Youth Skiff, RRS 44.1 and RRS P2.1 are changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

## 12. INTERNATIONAL JURY

An International Jury will be appointed in accordance with rule RRS 91(b). Its decisions will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

## 13. SCORING

13.1 RRS Appendix A will apply

13.2 At least 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta. When 5 or more opening series races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

13.3 In a Medal Stage Race, a boat's score shall be double the number of points specified in RRS Appendix A 4.1, and the score for that race shall not be excluded from the event series score.

13.4 Ties in the series score between boats with different medal race point scores shall be broken in favour of the boat that scored better in the final medal stage race. This changes RRS Appendix A8.

## **14. SUPPORT BOATS AND PERSONNEL**

- 14.1 All support boats shall be registered with the organizing authority and will be required to comply with local legislation and event support boat regulations. The organizing authority may refuse registrations and accept later registrations at their sole discretion.
- 14.2 All support boats shall clearly display the 3 letter national code of their World Sailing Member National Authority at all times while afloat. The minimum height for the letters shall be 200 mm. and visible from both sides of the boat.
- 14.3 Support boats with team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the starting sequence until all boats have finished or the Race Committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.
- 14.4 All coaches and team leaders shall present the coach boat insurance. Spanish coaches shall present a valid technical license (RFEV).

## **16. BERTHING**

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the Club and beach boat parks.

## **17. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS**

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make nor receive radio transmissions, text messages or cellular phone calls while racing except in an emergency or when using equipment provided by the Race Committee.

## **18. PRIZES**

- 18.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 boats in each event.
- 18.2 Only Olympic Classes are eligible for the absolute winner trophy "MANUEL ALBALAT IN MEMORIAM TROPHY".

## **19. INSURANCE**

Each participating crew shall present a valid insurance certificate showing proof of third-party liability coverage of at least 1,500,000 Euros (or equivalent) per incident.

## **20. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race.

The Organizing Committee or any part involved with the organization of the event disclaim any and every responsibility whatsoever for loss, damage, injury or inconvenience that might occur to persons and goods, both ashore and at sea as a consequence of participation in the races covered by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

## 21. MEDIA RIGHTS

21.1 By participating in the event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and their sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.

21.2 Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment or positioning equipment as specified by the Organizing Authority.

21.3 The top three competitors as well as the individual race winners may be required to attend a media press conference each day.

21.4 Competitors may be required for interviews at the regatta.

## 22. TRAINING

From 17<sup>th</sup> November to 17<sup>th</sup> December there will be free training for all sailors participating in the Christmas Race who have entered and paid the entry fee.
